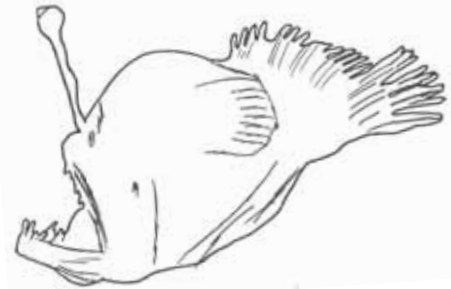


Creep into the DEEPEND™

STUDIES:

How marine communities are affected by human activities.



DEEPEND FOCUS

My job is to analyse the data that gets collected at sea, and use it to work out where different species live and how their abundances might change over time. This can help us predict how human impacts (like oil drilling) might affect them in the future

HAS STUDIED:

Methods to quantify and reduce bycatch in the Scottish langoustine fishery; parasites in cod (and how to get rid of them before someone eats them); how deep-sea demersal fish are influenced by natural drivers and human impacts.
